



OIL PAINTING FOR PLEASURE

BEGINNING/INTERMEDIATE

This class is **great** for adults who want to learn the techniques of oil painting for pleasure. My goal is to help my students have a great time creating a painting that they will be proud to hang in their home. First time students will receive a free 1 hour lesson before the first class. It will be from 11 am to noon on the day of the first class and will focus on mixing colors and brush strokes.

Susan W. Marcley, an award-winning California artist, began her artistic career under the tutelage of Herr Ernest W. Krupp in Machenbach, Germany in the 1960s. In 1968, Ms. Marcley opened the Lunde School of Art in Florida where she taught oil painting techniques for several years. She returned to formal instruction by studying the art of portraiture under Rafael Maniago, a member of the Portrait Society of America.

Ms. Marcley's educational experience continued in Italy where she studied classical drawing at the Angel Academy of Art in Florence. She returned the following year to study the art of painting the figure in oil from founder, teacher and artist John Micheal Angel, a protégé of Annigoni.

Susan Marcley lives in San Clemente, California. For the past six years she has enjoyed teaching beginning and intermediate oil painting classes at Talega Gallery.
